POW has 14 residential cabins. 13 saloons having 03 twin bedded rooms in each saloon (deluxe cabins). The cabins have been created in three different themes in hues of exquisite jewels, Ruby, Sapphire and Pearl. Each and every saloon of the luxury train has been named after the erstwhile princely states. The names are Alwar, Bharatpur, Bikaner, Bundi, Dholpur, Dungepur, Jaipur, Jaisalmer, Jhalawar, Jodhpur, Kishangarh, Kota, Sirohi and Udaipur. 01 saloons are having 02 Super Deluxe Cabins (Suites).

PALACE ON WHEELS INFORMATION

E. PRE & POST TOUR ACCOMMODATION:

The guests are suggested to at least book one day of hotel accommodation before and after the train journey.

F. INTERNATIONAL AND DOMESTIC FLIGHT:

The cost of the domestic or international flight is not included in the prices of Palace on Wheels; however, we provide assistance in both international and domestic air ticket booking.

G. TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We always recommend our guests to carry the insurance documents collected from their home country that cover insurance policy in regards to illness, injury, accident, death, loss of luggage and holiday cancellation. However, all passengers are covered well under an umbrella of insurance that encompasses unforeseen calamities like fire, earthquake, theft and terrorism by Indian railway during the journey period only.

H. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

Travel Documents, which are valid only for the passenger(s) named, will be issued after receipt of full payment for your reservation. Please carry your confirmation of booking with you on departure.

I. EXTENSIONS:

If you wish to extend your holidays in India and visit other fascinating destinations after a weeklong train tour, you can let us know of your preferred destinations or travel idea. We offer select pre-packaged tours and tailor made itineraries to some of the most exclusive destinations in India.

J. DRESS CODE:

Smart casual clothing and suitable walking shoes are recommended for off-train excursion tours. For all the wildlife tours, guests are suggested to wear comfortable clothes in natural restraint hues so that it can blend well with the landscapes. The bright colored clothes are better avoided during wildlife excursions. You also need to carry warm clothes during winter season departure.

K. BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

As there is a little storage space inside your personal cabins, so passengers are requested to carry luggage as per the international airline rules for the first/business class passengers. Soft-topped luggage is always recommended as these can be stored easily.

L. SPECIAL DIETARY:

If you have any special dietary requirements, please mention it at the time of booking so as to avoid disappointments during your journey. All the efforts are directed towards a pleasing journey experience for the travelers and thus, we also need your support to offer quality services every time.

M. PORTER:

A well trained, English speaking guide accompanies the guests during their off-train excursion tours. The guide is provided with a view to offer the guests an in-depth and detailed insight of the various destinations and historical monuments covered in each excursion. R. TRANSPORTATION DURING OFF TRAIN EXCURSIONS:

Comfortable and fully air-conditioned coach transfers are available for passengers during their off-train excursion tours.

S. SMOKING POLICY:

As per Indian Law - Smoking in India is prohibited in all public places. However, those who wish to smoke can contact the captain for the same.

T. MEDICAL AID:

First aid is available on the train whereas a doctor can be arranged on call at every Destination. Doctor is available for 1 hrs. for free consultancy in Bar/ Lounge car.

U. HEALTH:

While travelling to India, no specific vaccination is required, but foreigners need to carry their Yellow Fever Vaccination certificate conforming to international health regulations, if they are originating or traveling through Yellow Fever prevalent countries. You also need to take precautions for malaria. Please consult your physicians before embarking on the journey. If you are on a medication, carry sufficient amount of medicines required during the span of the journey. Mosquitoes and insects repellents are also need to be carried to be safe from the hands of diseases and allergies.

V. LAUNDRY:

Laundry service is available on board in Jaipur and Udaipur to serve you better.

W. CELL PHONES:

All the passengers are requested to keep their cell phones on silent mood while on board or during off-train excursion tours. In all the public areas of the train, the use of cell phones and laptops are restricted. You can use these services in the privacy of your cabins.

DAY 03: FRIDAY, SAWAI MADHOPUR – THE BIG CAT; ARRIVAL 0530 HRS. DEPARTURE 2230 HRS.

Sawai Madhopur the Ranthambore national park at junction of the Aravali and the Vindhyas is a unique juxtaposition of natural and historical richness, standing out conspicuously in the vast, arid and denuded tract of eastern Rajasthan, barely 14 Kms from Sawai Madhopur.

A 1000-year-old Ranthambore Fort of great historical importance atop a high hill stand tall remain of the historical part cenotaphs, tombs, stepped well, summer palace etc., have all merged harmoniously in to the sprawling forest.

Three big lakes- Padam Talav, Malik Talav and Raj bag- are alike turquoises studded in the vast tract. Though a delicate eco system, Ranthambore is dynamic in the diversity and density of fauna it supports. Tiger at the apex of the food chain lords over the kingdom in a subtle way solitary by nature. It operates with stealth. Quite naturally tiger sighting is always a matter of chance, though evidences of its activities are equally exciting other than tigers you may have opportunity to see 24 different species of mammals, spotted deer, sambhar, wild boar, Indian Gazel, Jungle cat, Panthers, Jackal, Hynas Rarely sloth bears, also almost 300 different kind of birds.

But a glimpses at this giant abodes of Rajput still fills on with thrill. The fort is accessible after ceremony seven gates. Rana Kumbha palace and Padamini Palace in the fort are considered as master pieces of Rajput architecture Padmini Palace had been the residence of beautiful queen Rani Padmini.

DAY 04: SATURDAY, UDAIPUR – THE LAKE CITY; ARRIVAL 0800 HRS. DEPARTURE 1530 HRS.

The capital of the Sisodia Maharanas, enjoy pre-eminence among the Rajput clans of Rajasthan spend the day sightseeing at Udaipur Maharana Udai Singh, Laid the foundation for a new kingdom Udaipur situated at Lake Pichola where the impressive city palace was lavished with aesthetic and imaginative work of art miniature painting was encouraged.

Subsequently the princes built the seemingly floating Island Palace, the royal summer retreat, offering a spectacular view of the lake and surrounding mountains.

The western most citadel of the desert, Jaisalmer has an ancient history linked with its development as a trading center. Located en-route one of the two passages, that connected India with Persia, Egypt Africa and West. The Bhati Rajput sole guardians of the city accumulate enough wealth through tax levied on the passing carwans. Jaisalmer amid picturesque a marvel of beautiful culture and harsh climate conditions. The Sonar Quila Fort, made of yellow sand stone will immediately command your attention here.

The city is also known for its old mansion better known as Havelies. Patwon Ki Haveli and Nathmalgi Ke Haveli, Salim Singh Ji Ki Haveli most striking architecture a fine blend of ancient and the medieval era. Shopping and lunch at Moomal Hotel. The sweeping sand dunes, enjoy the romance of solitude at Kuldhara and your camel takes you deep in the Thar desert, the set hare is the most awaited experience. As the sun sets the rolling golden dunes the surreal experience is worth. Though the winter, followed by the cultural performance - campfire with dinner in dunes.

The city best known for its indigo-hued homes and buildings, Jodhpur is the former capital of the Marwar. The Mehrangarh Fort was built by Rao Jodha in 1459 and later his successions also added new structures. The fort is situated 120 meters high rocky hill, this fort is witness the lavish and royal history of Rathore.

Fort stands on strong and wide walls, which are 20 to 120 feet high and 12 to 70 feet thick its gigantic structure and finely carved intricate sculpture are a treat for eye.

The royal structure boasts their own saga of security and beauty the Perl palace has a delicately carved stone screen, umaid Vilas displays the Rajput miniature paintings and the Ajit Vilas exhibits musical instruments and the royal costumes. Shopping of local handicrafts.

Umaid Bhawan Palace world's finest and largest palace in the world Maharaja Umaid Singh utilized the services of a well-known Edwardian architect, henry Vaughan lanchester for the construction of this palace. There are 347 rooms in the palace that boast about its grandness and splendor the central dome that has become the identity of the palace 110 feet high. The royal family in still lives a part of the palace also having the old clock museum.

DAY 07: TUESDAY, BHARATPUR/AGRA; ARRIVAL 0500 HRS. DEPARTURE 2045 HRS.

Bharatpur A royal kingdom where the jats, rather than the Rajputs, ruled. Bharatpur's Jat History is not too old, with Suraj Mal establishing a firm stronghold in a region contested by both the Rajputs and the Mughals. Suraj Mal exploits are legendary, and the fort, Lohargarh, or Iron Fort, has a history that recounts it with pride. The only fort in the state to have bastions of mud, these proved meritorious because they simply swallowed up the cannon shells not allowing them to impact.

The Keoladeo Ghana National Park one of the finest bird sanctuary in the world was developed by a royal edict when dykes were created so that water could be canalized for the hunting preserve as the Maharaja of Bharatpur wished to create.

Over three hundred species of birds many of them migrant species that come from parts as distant as Siberia and China.
